Statement of Purpose

The Jack and Lois Kravitz Fund for Leadership Development of the Dallas Jewish Community Foundation was established to enhance the development of lay and professional leadership in Dallas. The Fund was established in 1984 by many friends of Jack and Lois Kravitz in honor of their 50th wedding anniversary. Jack was the Executive Director of the Dallas Jewish Federation from 1943 to 1973.

The purpose of this Fund is to foster leadership development of volunteers in Dallas Jewish Communal activities. This purpose will be achieved through varied and flexible means. Support may be given to programs in Dallas dedicated to the subject of volunteer leadership training. Local or outside experts, lay or professional, may be involved in these programs. Funds may also be used to enable individuals, lay or professional, to undertake special training in volunteer leadership development.

Approximately \$2,500.00 may be available for grants from the Kravitz Fund. Your organization is invited to submit a proposal for a creative project, which is in line with the purpose of the Fund.
