Meyer's background includes many years of professional leadership in Jewish communal work, with broad experience in annual and planned giving. He spent 8 years as the president of the United Jewish Community of Las Vegas, where a national award for campaign excellence was achieved several times. During his tenure, Las Vegas was defined by the UJC as "the fastest growing Jewish Federation in North America." Prior to that, he was executive director of the Jewish Federation of Central Massachusetts; executive director of the Jewish Federation of Southern Maine and executive director of the Jewish Community Center of Central New York.

He has a bachelor's degree in social work from Temple University in Philadelphia, Pa., and has completed graduate courses in social work, psychology and public administration.
